### Who We Are

Abhyudaya Global Village School (AGVS) is reimagining education for rural India. Based in Maharashtra, we serve as a living, breathing campus where learning is not confined to textbooks. Our mission is to nurture self-learners, critical thinkers, and rooted citizens who can contribute meaningfully to the re-emergence of Bharat.

### Key Highlights (2024–25)

- **Children Impacted:** 300+ students, including 30+ residential children
  - **Teachers Empowered:** 25+ Aacharyas trained in module-based, interest-led learning
  - **Modules Running:** Agriculture, Business, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Art & Music, Food & Cooking, Self & Society
  - **Community Employment:** 60+ local villagers employed across school and campus units
  - **Medium of Learning:** Bilingual (Marathi & English) with strong local cultural anchoring
  - **4th Batch Passed Out:** Students scored between 65% and 92%
  - **Student Start-up:** Mushroom Farming start-up Gronex on campus by two 10th standard students.

### What Makes AGVS Unique?

- We run on the principle of "*learning by doing*" — children take roles as cooks, farmers, bankers, artists
  - Financial literacy through an internal "Learning Unit" economy
  - Gender equality: 50/50 girl to boy ratio maintained
  - Zero coercion, zero shouting: discipline through mutual respect
  - Fully residential care for rural children with minimal resources
